## Occupational Testing

Our certified instructors are able to provide the following on-site tests for your employees:

- Hearing Tests (Baseline and Annual) – Monitoring their hearing may save your utility thousands of dollars.
- Pulmonary Function Tests (PFTs) – Determines whether or not they are medically fit to wear respirators.
- Respirator Fit Tests – Do they know how to take care of their respirators? Do they know the proper way to wear their respirators? Are the respirators they currently wear safe?
- Sound Level Monitoring – Are they exposed in their daily work to noise levels higher than is acceptable?

## General Safety Training (OSHA, DOT, etc.)

Periodic or monthly safety classes to keep in compliance with OSHA and other regulatory agencies are available on request. These sessions will encourage better safety practices (helping to eliminate injuries and illnesses) and encourage working together as a team. Besides compliance issues, our main goal is to send your employees home every night safe and whole.

Approximately 61 safety classes are available to individual cities or through cooperative efforts with groups of other utilities. IAMU currently offers training to eleven clusters including 180+ cities throughout the state and an additional thirteen individual contracts.

## Consultation / Written Program Audits

Instructors will come to your facility to review your programs and help you achieve compliance.

## Mock OSHA Walk-through inspections

Are you aware of potential safety violations in your work environment? Make arrangements for a Mock OSHA Inspection at your facility to eliminate these hazards before they become a liability. Stress-free visits can be scheduled on request and a written report will be available. In addition Forklift Proficiency and Ergonomic Observation can be requested.
